(hereinafter referred to as "**we**" or "**EUROPOLIS**") acts as data controller within the meaning of the General Data Protection Regulation ("**GDPR**").

This privacy policy informs you about the way and extent to which we process your personal data when you visit our website. Unless otherwise stated in this privacy policy, we (or our processors) collect your personal data directly from you and do not obtain it from third parties.

We are aware of the importance of your data and therefore do not transfer it to third countries (*i.e.*, countries outside the European Economic Area) or to international organizations. If individual data processing operations nevertheless involve the transfer of your data to a third country, we will expressly notify you thereof in this privacy policy, including informing you of the measures we have taken to ensure the required level of protection for your data.

You are neither legally nor contractually obligated to provide your personal data. Furthermore, the provision of your personal data is not necessary for the fulfillment of a contract. You are not obligated to provide the personal data, but without this data the use of our homepage or individual functions thereof might not be possible.

We do not use your data for automated decision-making including profiling in the sense of Art. 13 para. 2 lit. f and Art. 14 para. 2 lit. g GDPR.

Due to the further development of our website or legal changes, it may become necessary to amend this privacy policy. The current version of privacy policy is published on the webpage, and this version shall apply.

Cookies & Tracking

Cookies are small files that are stored on your end device (e.g., PC/laptop, tablet or smartphone). These files are downloaded from your browser when you visit our website. If a cookie is not deleted automatically (for example, immediately after your visit to our website), the cookie and the information stored in it will be sent back to the respective website that generated it (first party cookie) or to another website to which it belongs (third party cookie), when you call up this website again with the same end device or browser. In this way, the website "recognizes" that it deals with the same user and enables the provision of certain functionalities, such as customizing the display of content on the website. Cookies can, for example, "remember" your preferences, tell how you use a page, and/or customize the offers displayed in part to your preferences.

Functional cookies. We use several functional cookies on our website. When we use functionally necessary cookies, we process your personal data in order to provide basic functions of our websites and the services you have requested, as well as to temporarily store your cookie settings. Without the use of these cookies, we would not be able to provide the website or there would be functional limitations.

Non-functional cookies. We use several non-functional cookies on our website. These cookies are not functionally necessary for the operation of our website and include, for example, cookies to analyze user behavior on websites, or cookies to show you advertisements.

Your data subject rights

As a data subject, you have the following rights in relation to the processing of your personal data:

Right to withdraw consent

If we process your data based on your consent, you are entitled to withdraw your consent at any time. After receiving your withdrawal, we will no longer process this data. However, the withdrawal of consent will not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out up to the time of the withdrawal.

Right of access

You can request information about the data processed about you, in particular about the origin and categories of the data processed, the storage period, the recipients to whom your personal data have been disclosed, the purpose and nature of the processing. Upon request, we will provide you with a copy of the personal data we process about you. We would like to point out that no information is to be provided if this would jeopardize business or trade secrets of the controller or third parties.

Right to rectification

If we process data about you that is incorrect or incomplete, you may request that it be corrected or completed - also by means of a supplementary declaration.

Right to erasure

You have the right to request that we delete the personal data concerning you.

We would like to point out that a right to deletion might not exist in specific cases, e.g. if we have to process the data in order to fulfill a legal obligation or in order to be able to assert, exercise or defend legal claims.

Right to restriction of processing

You have the right to request the restriction of the processing of your personal data carried out by us, for example, if the accuracy of the personal data is disputed by you, for a period of time that allows us to verify the accuracy of such personal data.

Right to data portability

If we process personal data about you that you have provided to us, you may, under certain circumstances, request that this data be transferred to you in a machine-readable format. You may also instruct us to transfer this data directly to a third party of your choice, if this is technically feasible.

Right to lodge a complaint

Although we make strong commitments to protect the privacy and integrity of your personal data, disagreements about the way we use your personal data cannot be ruled out. You therefore have the right to lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority. This could be, among others, the supervisory authority at your place of residence or at our location.

RIGHT TO OBJECT
